 - Outstanding student supports
 - Emphasis on experiential & high impact learning
 - Alignment with state & regional workforce needs
- Adding
 - Reimagination of GenEd
 - Innovative/flexible modalities
 - Commitment to cohort experiences



Diversity, Equity, & Inclusion

- Keeping
 - Abiding, unambiguous institutional commitment
 - Comprehensive approach
 - Community connections
- Adding
 - Impacts all pillars and elements of the plan, e.g., teaching and learning
 - More specific definitions and metrics
 - Intentional accountability



Research & Innovation

- Keeping
 - Focus on applied research
 - Intentional community impact
 - Thoughtful integration with teaching
- Adding
 - Impacts in other elements of the plan
 - More specific definitions and metrics
 - Intentional accountability



Stewardship

- Keeping
 - Focus on student support / student success
 - Interest in supplemental revenue streams
 - Commitment to transparency/accountability
- Adding
 - Elements related to health & wellness
 - Intentional integration with master plan
 - References to dynamic operational needs
