Dear Parents,
During the month of December we will be concentrating on packages, stamps, and mail; wrapping paper and boxes. We will be mailing letters to your home so please check the mail with your toddler. Your toddlers will notice an increase in the arrival of packages in the mail or by delivery to the door and will spend a great deal of time wondering what all those boxes, packages and cards are for. We are going to have lots of fun shaking, rattling and opening packages and boxes as well as making letters/cards for family.

The month of December is a very hectic month for families. Here are a few suggestions for dealing with your little one during this time.

1. Try to keep their schedule as close to normal as possible. Naps and bedtimes especially. Remember even if they don't sleep resting quietly in your arms or on a cushion will rejuvenate them almost as well as a true nap.
2. Stickers, chalk, and bubbles!!! Stickers are universally great for calming a cranky or bored child. You and they may be covered but OK! Chalk wipes, brushes, or vacuums off anything so 1-2 pieces of chalk and some dark paper are a great thing to keep on hand when traveling. ...and Bubbles!! Well no explanation needed for bubbles]
3. Expect your baby to be shy at parties or family gatherings, even with people they know. Give them a little time before asking for hugs and kisses from people especially from people they don't know well. (Please be careful this year, and maintain social distance.)
