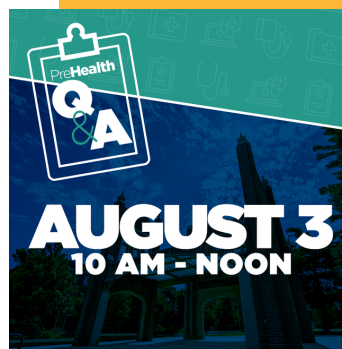
Periodic Ponderings: Medical School Showcase
