What sports are represented?

What is the cost? And budget?

\$80,000 is allocated from SAF to operate the intramural sports program on an annual basis.

Who is currently eligible to participate in intramurals?

All Students, Faculty & Staff of UTC.

*Alumni and retirees *are not* eligible.

Are faculty and staff excluded from participation? If so, why?

No, we just do not have many faculty/staff who participate in intramurals currently. Most games are schedule from 5pm-11pm, Sunday through Thursday, which could be one of the reasons but that is when students want to play after classes.

Could integrated staff-faculty-student teams potentially serve to enhance student retention, improve student-faculty-staff relationships, and encourage employee fitness?

Certainly! Team Sports can indeed strengthen interpersonal relationships, and provided common ground for Students & Faculty to interact during competition.

How is recruiting for intramural teams handled? Through clubs? Emails? Posters?

We "recruit" through Campus advertisement via email, posters, cards, even now social media and www.IMLeagues.com/UTC. In the future we will be introducing the phone app through campus recreation.

For UTC to offer a more robust intramural program, with sports offered to all UTC personnel, what would be the approximate cost?

This is hard to estimate because we base the budget on number of teams and sports offered for each sport, which are supervised and officiated by student employees. If we continue to grow in teams and sports, which come from faculty/staff teams then we could estimate in increase in need to operate the intramural program.

Would an enhanced intramural program offer more opportunities for on-campus student employment?

Yes, more teams and games means we would need more student official's and supervisors to cover the games and teams.

What do our rival schools offer in the way of intramurals?

Depending on the particular schools, a lot of universities in NIRSA and intramural programs allow all students and faculty/staff to participate in intramurals on-campus. If the university can operate on the allocated budget then programs do not charge a team entry fee. Most intramural programs are forced to charge all participants a team entry fee to offset expenses if the allocated budgets cannot sustain the programs.
