Integrated Studies Steps to Graduation

2. Complete and submit the Integrated Studies Inquiry Form: <http://www.utc.edu/integrated-studies/integrated-studies-concentration/inquiry-form.php>. The Integrated Studies Administrative Assistant, Madison Dell, will contact you within 2 business days to set an informational appointment.

3. Formulate a plan of study

4. Complete Course Plan Approval Application: written plan of how classes integrate into complete degree, including 2 page personal statement of how specific classes will integrate into a degree. Submit the application electronically (email attachment) to the Program Director. The Director will submit the application to the Integrated Studies Committee for approval. (NOTE: As per the program guidelines, the degree plan must be approved by the Integrated Studies Committee prior to the student earning 42 hours, or within the first semester for students entering with 42 or more earned hours.)
5. Attend advising with Program Director or assigned advisor every semester and complete courses in approved plan, collect documents for portfolio (syllabi, papers, etc...)
6. Maintain 2.0 GPA in Integrated Studies course plan
7. Successfully complete capstone course in semester prior to graduation
