

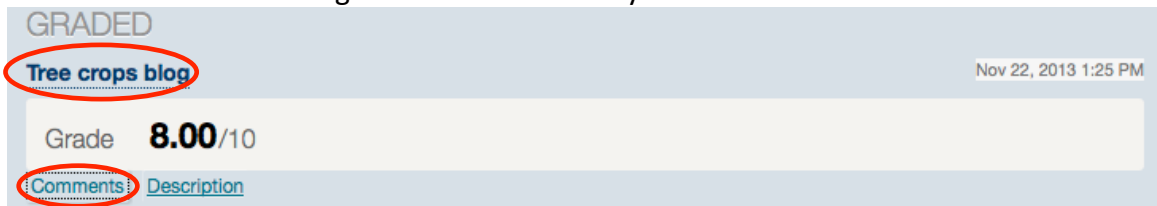

WHY WOULD YOU USE THIS FEATURE:

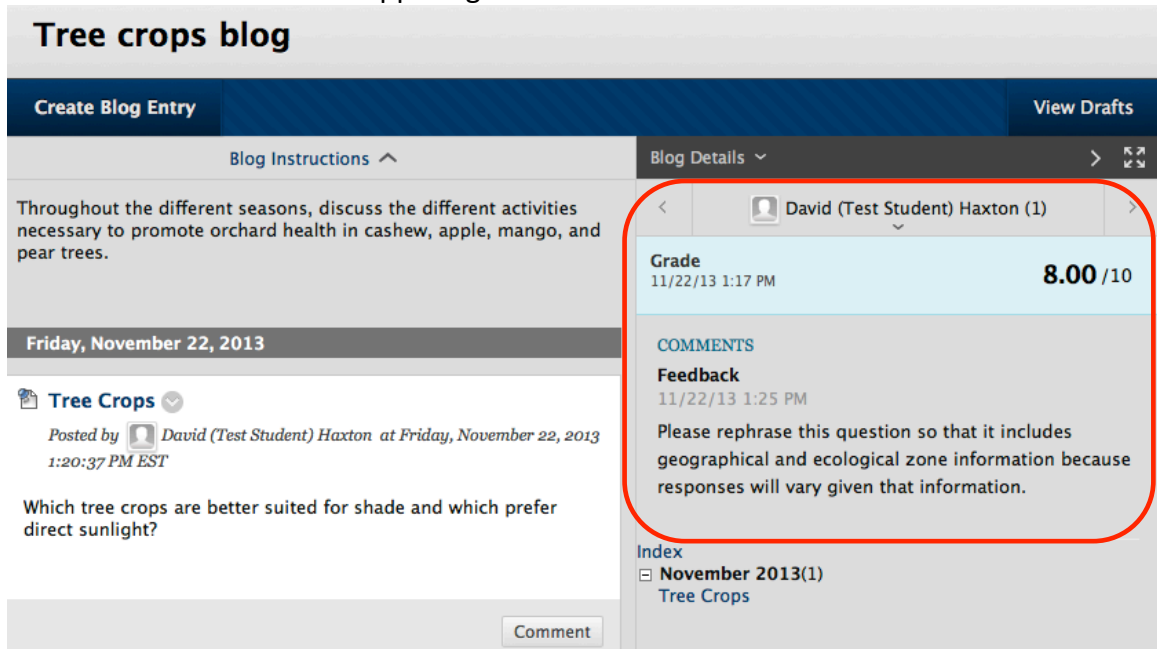
After your blog entry has been reviewed and graded by your instructor you may access your grade and their feedback through **My Grades** or the **Journals** area.

HOW TO VIEW BLOG GRADE AND FEEDBACK:

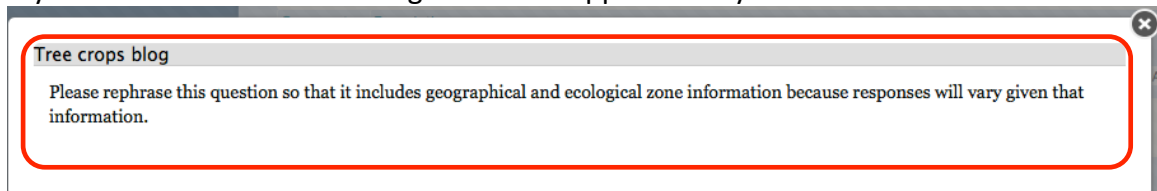
1. Access your course followed by **My Grades**.
2. Scroll down until you reach the blog you submitted under the heading **Graded**.
3. Select the **Title** of the blog or **Comments** directly below.




4. If you select the **Title** you will be directed to the blog entry with your grade and instructors feedback in the upper right.



5. If you select **Comments** a dialogue box will appear with your instructor's feedback.
