


Capturing Direct Links to Articles: JSTOR


JSTOR provides access to full-text content from 1,500 journals in the humanities, social sciences, and sciences. Follow these directions to capture direct links to articles from JSTOR.

1. Search for an article within [JSTOR](#).

4. Add the following prefix to the stable URL: <http://proxy.lib.utc.edu/login?url=>

3. The URL can now be used from both on- and off-campus. Off-campus users will be prompted to enter their UTC ID/PW before getting to the full text.
