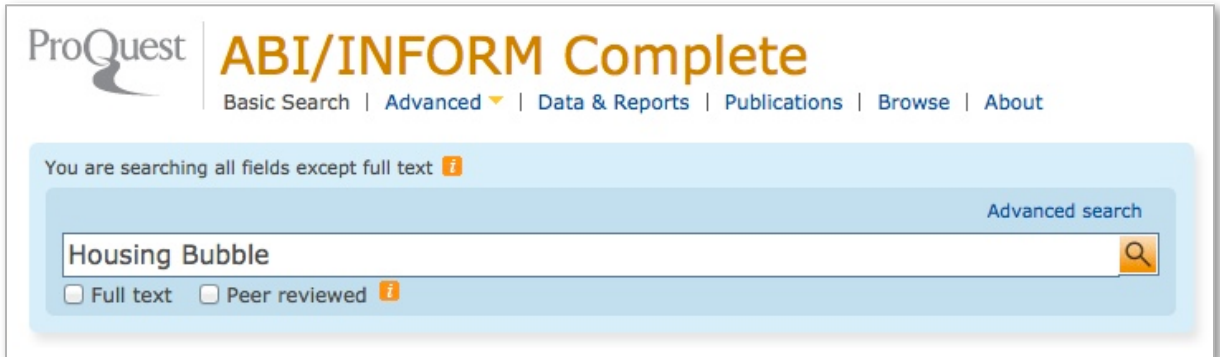


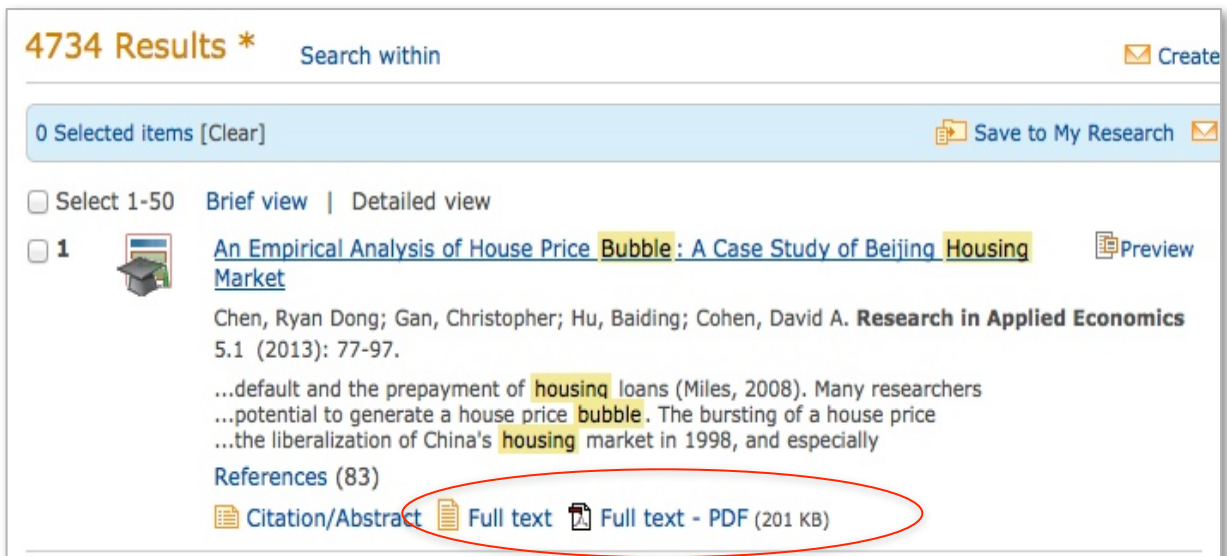
## Capturing Direct Links to Articles: ProQuest Databases

ProQuest is one of the many vendors that provides access to full-text article content via online databases subscribed to by the UTC Library. The library subscribes to the following [ProQuest Databases](#). Follow these directions to capture direct links to articles from ProQuest databases.

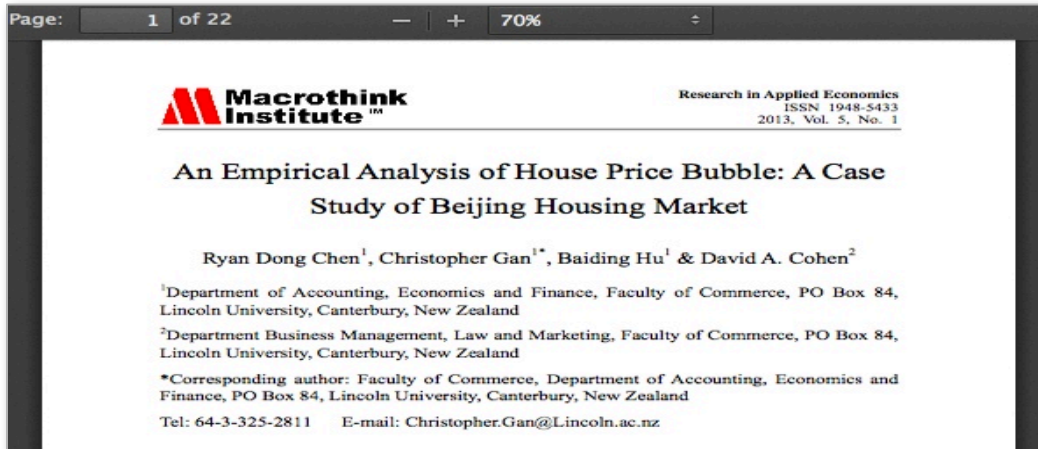
1. Search for an article within a [ProQuest Databases](#).



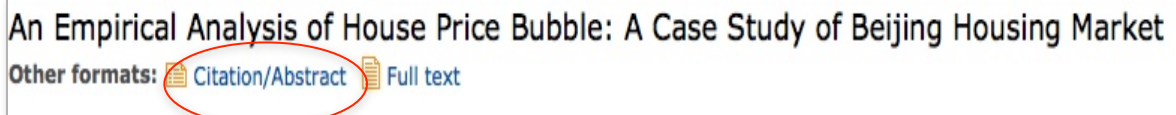
2. Articles with available full-text online content will include a link to either "PDF" or "HTML" Full Text. This link will follow the article summary on the result page. Click on the link to make sure full text is available.



3. The full text will open within the browser window.

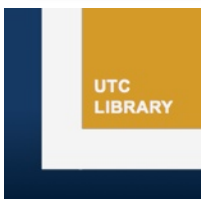


4. After verifying full text, Click on the link that says "Citation/Abstract" located at the top of the page underneath the article title. This will take you back to the citation/abstract view for the article.



5. Scroll to the bottom of the page to locate the "Document URL." This URL is the permanent URL to this article. Copy this link and paste it into any Blackboard course, e-mail, or other document. The URL can be used by both on- and off-campus users. Off-campus users will be prompted to enter their UTC ID/PW before being allowed access to the content.
