COURSE PLACEMENT: MATH

If your major requires* a specific score to enroll and your Math ACT is 18 or lower, you have three options:

- 1. Enroll in the Step Ahead Math (SAM) program.
 Only available during summer.
- 2. Take the ACT Residual to increase your math ACT subscore.
- 3. Complete the appropriate math courses at a community college.



^{*}Some students may not place into a high enough level of math to complete this requirement in one semester.

- The Placement exam is encouraged for all students who have completed studies in a language and/or are native speakers of another language.


CLASS REGISTRATION: GENERAL RULES & GUIDELINES

- 12 hours = Full time enrollment
- Sophomore status begins at 30 earned hours
- UTC Minimum GPA for good standing = 2.0
- TELS/HOPE GPA requirement = 2.75 @ 24 attempted hrs



1. Log in to My MocsNet Account



3. You'll need to select My MocsNet on the next screen.




Academics tab will include links to view your schedule, links to your degree audit, and other quicklinks related to your academics.






Confirm you are declared your desired major. Use the "What If" option to run a MMD for other majors.

Red = outstanding requirement


Yellow = in progress

Green = completed




Academics tab will also include your assigned advisor, current major, and the link for class registration (Register, Add, or Drop Classes link)

CLASS REGISTRATION: CONTACT YOUR ADVISOR
