<sup>1</sup>Since the College of Business has only one true major along with several concentrations, the various concentrations have been used to track the retention and migration by each department. The various sub-concentrations within a concentration have been rolled into the main concentration for that department.

<sup>2</sup>The number of graduates have been removed from the initial enrollment in the formulas for the percentages for retention, migration, and non-returning students. An example of the formula would be: returning students/(initial enrolled majors - graduates).
