**WSTU: CHANGES TO THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE WOMEN'S STUDIES MINOR
8/26/2011**

RATIONALE: Women's Studies has been asked by the Records Office to bring the requirements for its minor in line with the capabilities of the new Degree Works program. This change will also make the requirements for the minor more similar in language to the requirements for the major.

OLD LANGUAGE: 18 hours required with at least 8 hours at the 300-400 level: Women's Studies 2000 and 15 hours Women's Studies courses listed below. However, no more than two courses (6 hours) in a single academic department can be applied toward the minor. Minimum 2.0 average required in all courses attempted for the minor.

NEW LANGUAGE: 18 hours required with at least 8 hours at the 300-400 level: Women's Studies 2000 and 15 hours distributed among approved Women's Studies Humanities and Women's Studies Social Science courses with at least one course from each category. Minimum 2.0 average required in all courses attempted for the minor.

Women's Studies Humanities courses include WSTU 3010, 3020, 3210, 3660, 4150, 4120, 4420, 4450r, 4550r, 4020, 4810, 4850, 4830.

Women's Studies Social Science Courses include WSTU 2020, 2220, 2950, 3040, 3050, 3070, 3240, 3360, 4170, 3180, 4340, 4510.

ECONOMIC AND PEDAGOGICAL CONSEQUENCES: None. This change will not impact the number or kind of courses offered each semester, and the new requirements are pedagogically similar in effect to the old ones. This change will not affect students' ability to complete the minor in a timely manner.

IMPACT ON OTHER DEPARTMENTS' REQUIREMENTS AND RESOURCES: None. This change will not require other departments to offer extra courses, extra sections, or new courses.
