### Action Items / Meeting Decisions:

- Pre-April 5th:
  - People.utc.edu:
    - Remove inactive students, faculty & staff
    - Suppress home information for everyone
    - Leave affiliates & friends in it
    - Take out employee type (leave primary affiliation)
  - OU Campus search:
    - Remove inactive faculty & staff
    - Remove students altogether
    - Remove other (which include affiliates)
- Post-April 5th (pending ITAC meeting)
  - People.utc.edu
    - Student view upon log-in only
- Broader/Long-term
  - Retrain people on updating information in people.utc.edu (or make HR or someone actually do it)
  - Look & feel of people.utc.edu for editing info, responsive, etc.

### Meeting Notes:

#### Context:

- Two ITAC meetings ago, Laurie brought up people.utc.edu issues coming to HR
- Last ITAC meeting the group asked IT to remove all students from directory and anyone who is not current.
- The Banner Team in Cooperation with the Network Team manage the directory with Greg coordinating w/Jamie & Weston

What are parameters for defining data sources & status - Jamie & Morgan - things to do with directory

3 options:

1. current directory is on UTC web search page
  - This pulls from LDAP
  - Could do a federated search
  - We could eliminate Student & Other
2. is on people.utc.edu
  - A directory, but all the source for students, faculty, and staff to self-update preferred names, office addresses, etc.
  - File received from IRIS as active
3. They are separate & we can display differently
  - We have ability to refine populations separately

- What you see in people.utc.edu publically is different than what you see if you are logged in.
- Question of updating preferred name for email aliases
- How do we handle Canon/Aramark?
  - They are affiliate, not necessarily in IRIS
  - They would need to have profiles in OU Campus
  - If we exclude most “others”, it’s hard to make exceptions for the temporary permanent folks like Aramark or Canon.
- People.utc.edu
  - Departments in IRIS are free-type field, which is problematic
  - People cannot update primary affiliation, email & employee type
  - Could we suppress home & personal information
- UT System’s 2FA project had a list of more up-to-date names and address of faculty and staff, approximately 2,200.
  - It was listed by cost center, but not department
  - IRIS is by cost center
- We have to keep people.utc.edu for the system features it provides for self-service
  - People automatically updates LDAP when self-service kicks in
  - Is there no self-service in IRIS?
- Argos can do limited number of partial UTC IDs
- Who uses this all that often? Operators, Professors
- Outlook is coming out of AD which is fed by LDAP
- Can we add affiliates upon log-on?
- How do we handle adjuncts?
- Explore IRIS as a self-service alternative?
- Friends (Ellucian) & Affiliates (Aramark/Canon)
