 - a. CIO Recruitment
 - i. Campus meetings/interviews next week
- 3. Training Task Force Cherie
 - a. New part of ITAC
 - b. Web presence on the ITAC website (along with the charge)
 - c. First item is to consider getting LinkedIn Learning
 - d. Central IT is using LinkedIn Learning (20ish licenses) & Pluralsight
 - e. Mostly hearing from folks, the need for training that syncs w/LinkedIn Learning
 - f. Courses related to Adobe, Canvas, Camtasia
 - g. 2k+ course titles
 - h. Recommendation is to roll it out from a Faculty/Staff point of access
 - i. Small discount for a 3-year license (could then possibly fold under a system-wide model)

 - k. Best use of training dollars, something we can track, can build out learning paths
 - I. Question will it feed into IRIS? It will work with K@TE. UTK has figured out how to integrate.

 - g. We are not yet proposing the hook into procurement/purchasing

 - i. Add "Identify" to beginning of second bullet
 - ii. Move third bullet to fourth bullet
 - i. Is this group comfortable with endorsing the TRB charge, tweaking the ITAC charge, and proposing recommended changes to the Chancellor?
