During fiscal year 2010-2011, the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga (UTC) has continued to work towards regional and national recognition as an engaged metropolitan university. The projects outlined in this report represent the broad scope of national and international research, creative endeavors, educational service, technological advances, and a commitment to




teaching, learning, and service which have become a hallmark of the UTC campus.




UTC SPONSORED PROGRAM AWARDS FY 2011






UTC SPONSORED PROGRAM PROPOSALS FY 2011






UTC SPONSORED PROGRAMS BY FUNCTIONAL AREA

FUNCTIONAL AREA DEFINITIONS

Research

Investigation undertaken to expand understanding, broaden the knowledge base, and generate new ideas and insights. Activities may include basic research (theoretical or experimental inquiry without regard to particular applications or potential commercial value). Includes funding for projects where the primary purpose is to acquire or maintain facilities or equipment that will be used primarily for research.

Public Service

Projects that provide non-instructional services that harness UTC's intellectual and cultural resources to benefit individuals and communities external to the institution.

Scholarships or Fellowships

External funding that is fully or primarily used to provide tuition support and/or trainee stipends.

Academic Services

External funding for instructional and training programs offered to UTC students, faculty, staff, or external constituencies. Includes funding for curriculum development, course implementation, enhancements to academic programs, etc.


Institutional Support

External funding for projects that benefit UTC as an institution but do not have a direct impact on the academic program.

Other

External funding for projects that cannot be classified within any of the above categories.













