Pool Party COVID-19 Protocols:

- **Social Distancing:** The party tables and chairs will be arranged to provide adequate social distancing while guests are eating and opening presents. Family units will be seated at the same tables.
- **Mask Requirement:** Masks are required while entering, exiting, using the spa, on the pool deck, and in the locker rooms. Masks may be removed while swimming and while eating at the socially distanced tables.
- **Youth Mask Requirement:** Youth under the age of 2 are not required to wear a mask.
- **Guest Tracking:** Each guest is required to complete a waiver prior to entering. The waiver includes name, address, and phone number. In the event of needing to conduct contact tracing, we will use the waivers to be able to identify each of the guests who attended.
- **Hosts:** Each Pool Party will have a Host. The Host is a Senior Lifeguard, Head Lifeguard, or Student Lead. This person is responsible for ensuring all staff and guests adhere to COVID-19 Protocols. They also are responsible for customer service and all logistics of the party.
- **Host Requirements:** The Host will meet guests at the Aquatics East Entrance, instruct them on basket use for their belongings and equipment, and direct them to the tables set up for the party. Since the Host will not be on guard duty during the party, it is their responsibility to ensure that social distancing, extensive cleaning, and other Campus Rec Covid-19 protocols are being followed by all guests and Aquatics staff. All Hosts are always required to wear a mask while at work.
- **Guards Requirements:** Each party will always have 3 up-guards with one down guard. The down-guard will assist the Host in enforcing social distancing between patrons. Lifeguards will follow the same rotation protocol as a regular shift. All Lifeguards are always required to wear a mask while at work.
- **Patrons Requirements:** Patrons will enter and exit through the doors located on the east side of the natatorium. The party space must be cleaned and sanitized after patrons leave in order to prevent unnecessary contact with the next party's guests.
- **Cleaning:** Patrons are not allowed to disinfect the pool furniture or pool party furniture themselves. The guards are responsible for disinfecting and will do additional disinfecting upon request.
- **Other:** Upon registration, the parents/guardians will be notified that Pool Parties are subject to change due to COVID-19. This could result in cancellations, activity changes, etc. Campus Recreation will remain fluid this summer to match changes and updates Campus Recreation and/or UTC initiates.
