ExamSoft Export Steps for Import to Canvas

Part 1

- 1. Login to <u>www.examsoft.com/utcbsn</u>.
- 2. Click on 'Assessments' at the top.
- 3. Click on the name of the assessment you want to export.
- 4. Scroll to the bottom and click on the 'Print/Export' button.
- 5. At the top make sure 'Exam Taker' is selected for Export Type and 'DOC' format is selected.
- 6. 'No visible item separation' should be selected for 'Question Layout' in the middle of the window
- 7. The only square box that should be ticked is 'Indicate Correct Answer (if applicable)' at the bottom right of the window under 'Advanced Settings'
- 8. Click 'Print/Export' to create a ZIP file.
- 9. After double-clicking on the file to unzip, open the DOC file with Microsoft Word.
- Replace all checkmarks with asterisks by copying a checkmark from an answer, going to Edit/Find/Replace, pasting the checkmark in the top field, typing an asterisk in the bottom field, and clicking 'Replace All'.
- 11. Go through all questions and manually replace the spelled-out question titles (i.e. 'Question #: 1') with the appropriate question number followed by a period ('1.') and make sure that each question is formatted as part of a numbered list.
- 12. Click 'File' and 'Save As', then make sure the file format is listed as 'Rich Text Format (.rtf)'.

Part 2

- 13. Open up Respondus and choose 'IMS QTI' for current personality.
- 14. Select 'Import Questions'
- 15. Choose 'Rich Text' for file type
- 16. Browse for the RTF file next to 'File Name'
- 17. Give the file a name in the 'Create a new document' area.
- 18. Click 'Preview' (you can ignore any errors about multiple file names)
- 19. Select 'Finish' and the click 'Ok'.
- 20. Go to the 'Preview + Publish' tab.
- 21. Click 'Save as' and the choose a destination and file name before clicking 'Ok'

Part 3

- 22. Open you Canvas course and click on 'Settings' in the course menu on the left.
- 23. Select the 'Import Course Content' option on the right.
- 24. Choose 'QTI .zip file'
- 25. Browse for the ZIP file under 'Choose file'
- 26. Create an associated question bank if desired
- 27. Click 'Import'
- 28. When import is complete, go to quizzes and preview to ensure quiz imported correctly.

Note 1: You will need to delete any photos in your test questions before you upload to Respondus. Images must be directly embedded in your Canvas questions.

Note 2: If you have questions with several correct answers, you will need to edit the question in Canvas, change the question type to 'Multiple Answers' and select all that apply.
