MGT 5000R Special Topics: Health Informatics Research Methods

Course Description: Health Informatics Research Methods is designed to provide students with the knowledge to collect, interpret and analyze data. Students will also examine basic methodologies most often used in health services administration research, quality improvement, and operations. Hands-on work with these methods will make up the core of the course deliverables. **Prerequisites:** Successful completion of online background module in statistics; grade of C or better in UTC MGT 2110, MATH 2100 or equivalent; or academic advisor approval based on academic record is required.
