- Review/complete any simple resources (i.e. inventory)/reading materials provided before/after a session (this will take approximately 20-30 minutes; to be provided later).
- Complete the assigned make-up task in the time allotted if you are not able to attend a session due to a circumstance or emergency (if applicable; to be provided later).
- Chat with your "accountability partner" at least once btwn September 30thth-November 10th.
- Schedule and attend (in-person or virtually) a 30-minute check-in conversation between
 September 30th and November 18th. The conversation should include you, your "accountability
 partner", and the Moc LEAD Student Coordinator or the Director of Leadership Development
 and Programs (sign-up will be provided during the September 29th Moc LEAD Session, but you
 can always schedule one via the calendly.com link in my email signature). This will be a coaching
 session related to the goals you set.
- Complete one brief self-awareness activity or attend a leadership event on/off-campus or
 virtually (preferably through your academic college) outside of Moc LEAD Sessions. Some
 activities or events may be eligible for additional ThinkAchieve Credit. You will be asked to
 identify the event that you participated in. Some possibilities will be provided throughout Moc
 LEAD (some can be seen below). Opportunities can also be found via MocSync.
