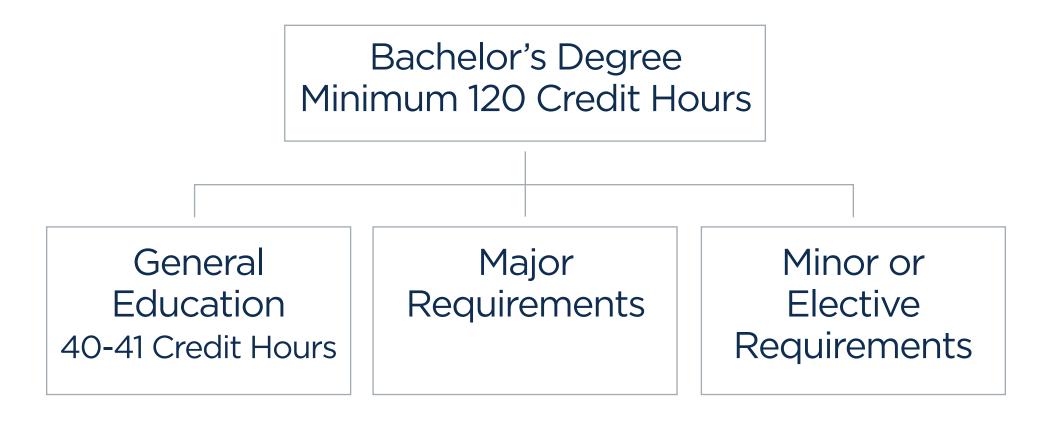


GENERAL EDUCATION

- Writing & Communication
- 6 credit hours
 - One approved course at 1000-level
 - One approved course at 1000- or 2000-level
- **Quantitative Reasoning**
- 6 credit hours
 - Two approved courses

BASED ON MATH ACT/SAT SUBSCORE*



*Math 2150 does not meet the general education requirement.



COURSE PLACEMENT: MATH

If your major requires* a specific score to enroll and your Math ACT is 18 or lower, you have four options:

- 1. Take the Math Placement Test.
- 2. Enroll in the Step Ahead Math (SAM) program. (Deadline to register for fall 2023 may have passed.)
- 3. Retake the ACT.
- 4. Take the appropriate development math course at a community college.

*Some students may not place into a high enough level of math to complete this requirement in one semester.



GENERAL EDUCATION

Natural Sciences

- 7-8 credit hours
 - One approved course with a lab
 - One approved non-lab or course with a lab
- **Behavioral & Social Sciences**
- 6 credit hours
 - It is recommended that courses be from different disciplines.



GENERAL EDUCATION

Humanities and Fine Arts

- 12 credit hours
 - Four approved courses from at least two prefixes
- Individual and Global Citizenship
- 3 credit hours
 - One approved course



COURSE PLACEMENT: FOREIGN LANGUAGE

- Foreign Language is not a general education requirement. All Bachelor of Arts degrees require a foreign language, and some additional majors may require one.
- The Placement exam is encouraged for all students who have completed studies in a language and/or are native speakers of another language.
- Offered online for Spanish.

CLASS REGISTRATION: GENERAL RULES & GUIDELINES


- 12 hours = Full time enrollment
- Sophomore status begins at 30 earned hours
- UTC Minimum GPA for good standing = 2.0
- TELS/HOPE GPA requirement = 2.75 @ 24 attempted hrs





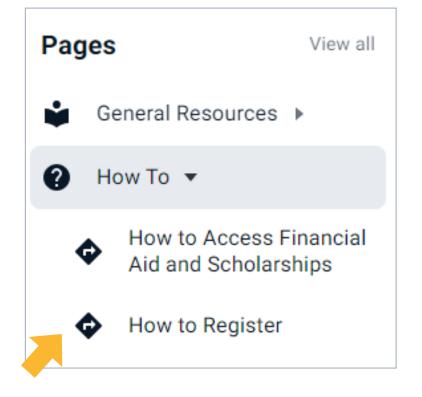
