# COURSE PLACEMENT: MATH

If your major requires\* a specific score to enroll and your Math ACT is 18 or lower, you have four options:

1. Take the Math Placement Test.
2. Enroll in the Step Ahead Math (SAM) program.  
*(Deadline to register for fall 2023 may have passed.)*
3. Retake the ACT.
4. Take the appropriate development math course at a community college.

\*Some students may not place into a high enough level of math to complete this requirement in one semester.

# GENERAL EDUCATION

## Natural Sciences

- 7-8 credit hours
  - One approved course with a lab
  - One approved non-lab or course with a lab

## Behavioral & Social Sciences

- 6 credit hours
  - It is recommended that courses be from different disciplines.

# GENERAL EDUCATION

## Humanities and Fine Arts

- 12 credit hours
  - Four approved courses from at least two prefixes

## Individual and Global Citizenship

- 3 credit hours
  - One approved course



# COURSE PLACEMENT: FOREIGN LANGUAGE

- Foreign Language is not a general education requirement. All Bachelor of Arts degrees require a foreign language, and some additional majors may require one.
- The Placement exam is encouraged for all students who have completed studies in a language and/or are native speakers of another language.
- Offered online for Spanish.

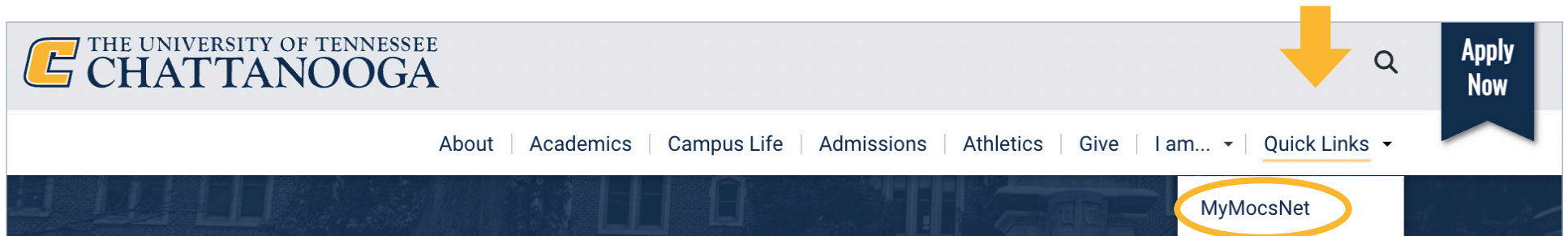
# **CLASS REGISTRATION: GENERAL RULES & GUIDELINES**

- 12 hours = Full time enrollment
- Sophomore status begins at 30 earned hours
- UTC Minimum GPA for good standing = 2.0
- TELS/HOPE GPA requirement = 2.75 @ 24 attempted hrs

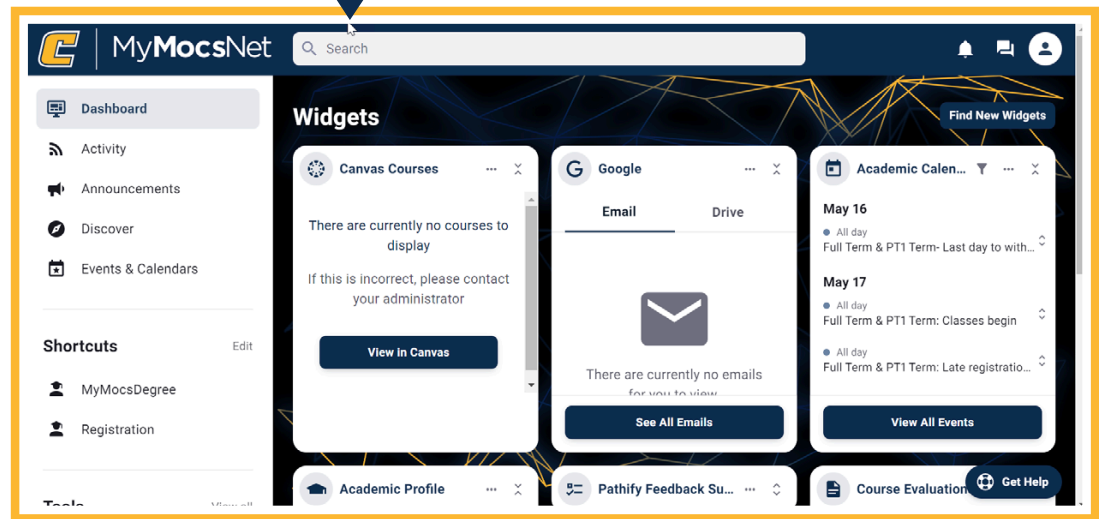

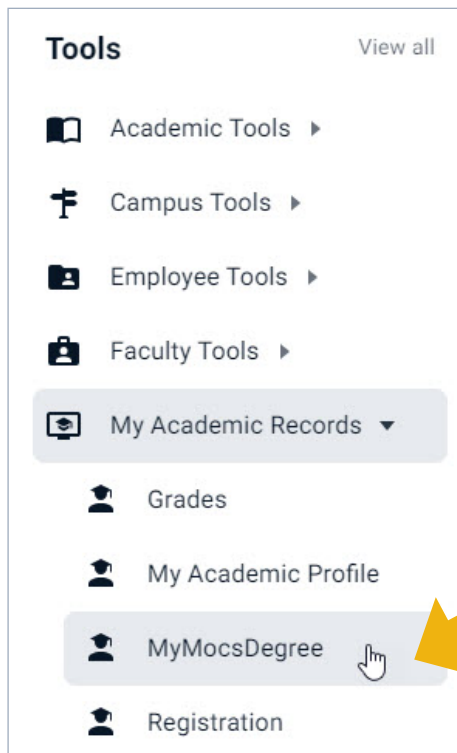
# CLASS REGISTRATION AND MYMOCSNET

3. MyMocsNet includes links to view your schedule and your degree audit, and other quick links related to your academics.

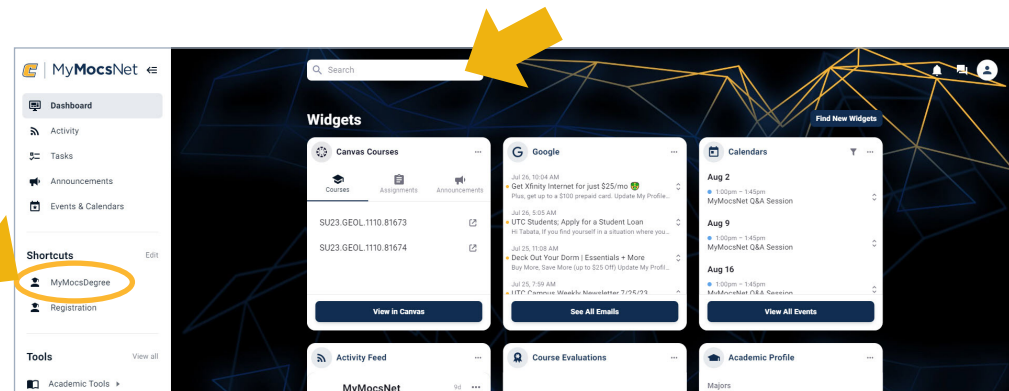
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# CLASS REGISTRATION AND MYMOCSDGREE

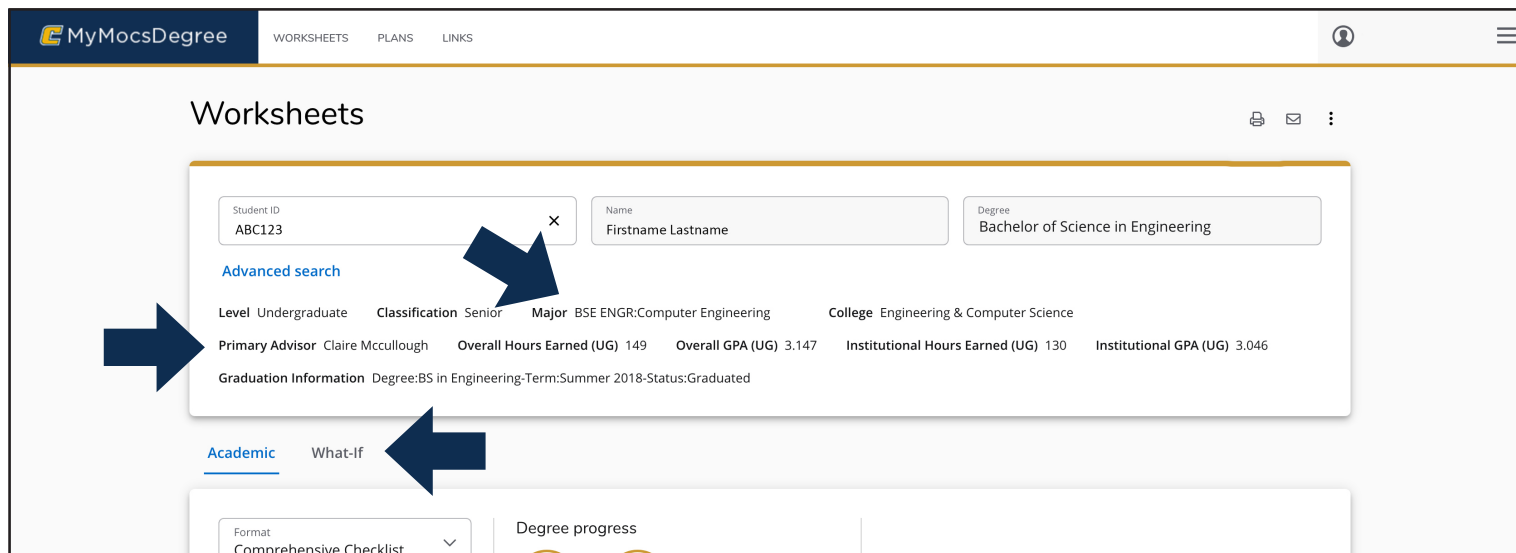

Confirm you are declared as your desired major.

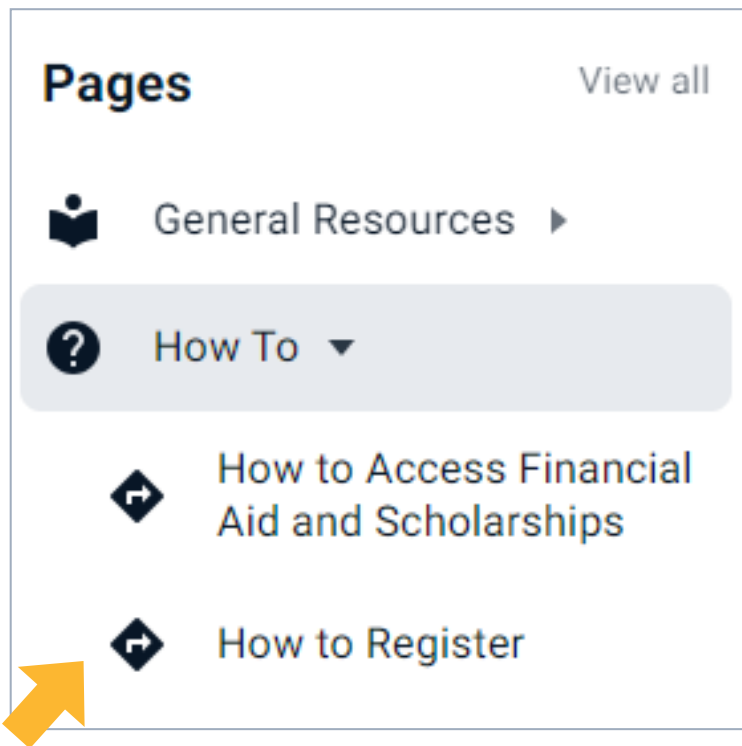
Make note of your primary advisor.

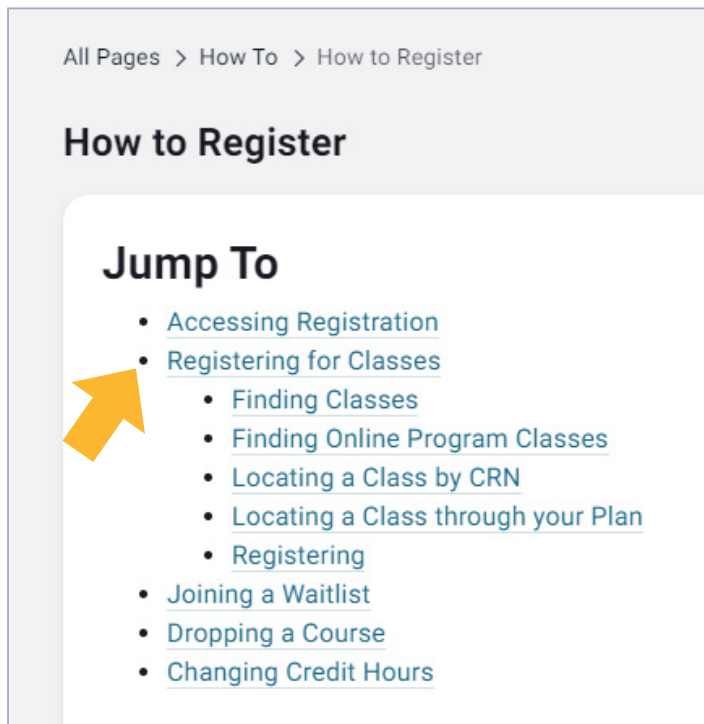
# CLASS REGISTRATION AND MYMOCSNET
