Curriculum to Leading Career (C2LC™) Pilot





What:

The primary objective of the Curriculum to Leading Career (C2LC) pilot is a short-term course designed to develop a clearable, knowledgeable microelectronics workforce to support and execute Air Force (and the larger DoD and Defense Industrial Base by extension), workforce modernization needs. The goal of C2LC is to familiarize students with the Department of Defense and how working for DoD can be a rewarding career. There may be an opportunity to gain an active Interim Secret security clearance to accelerate the onboarding process and get employees engaged in meaningful work sooner.

Benefits:

- Provides students with an education experience that prepares them for cleared jobs
- Accommodates new workforce entrants and those needing upskilling/reskilling
- Complements traditional STEM academic disciplines
- Provides employers a streamlined process for hiring and on-boarding
