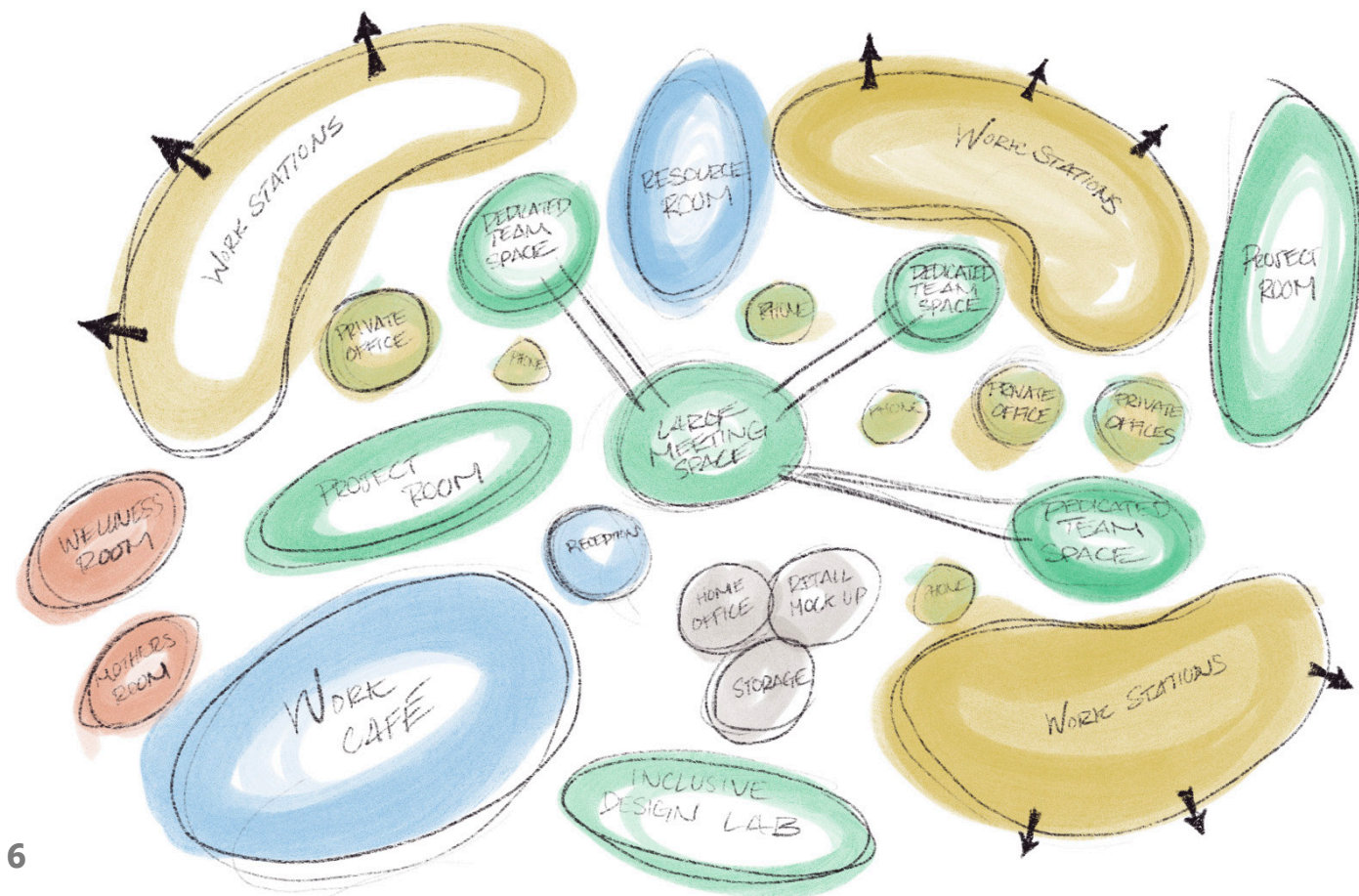

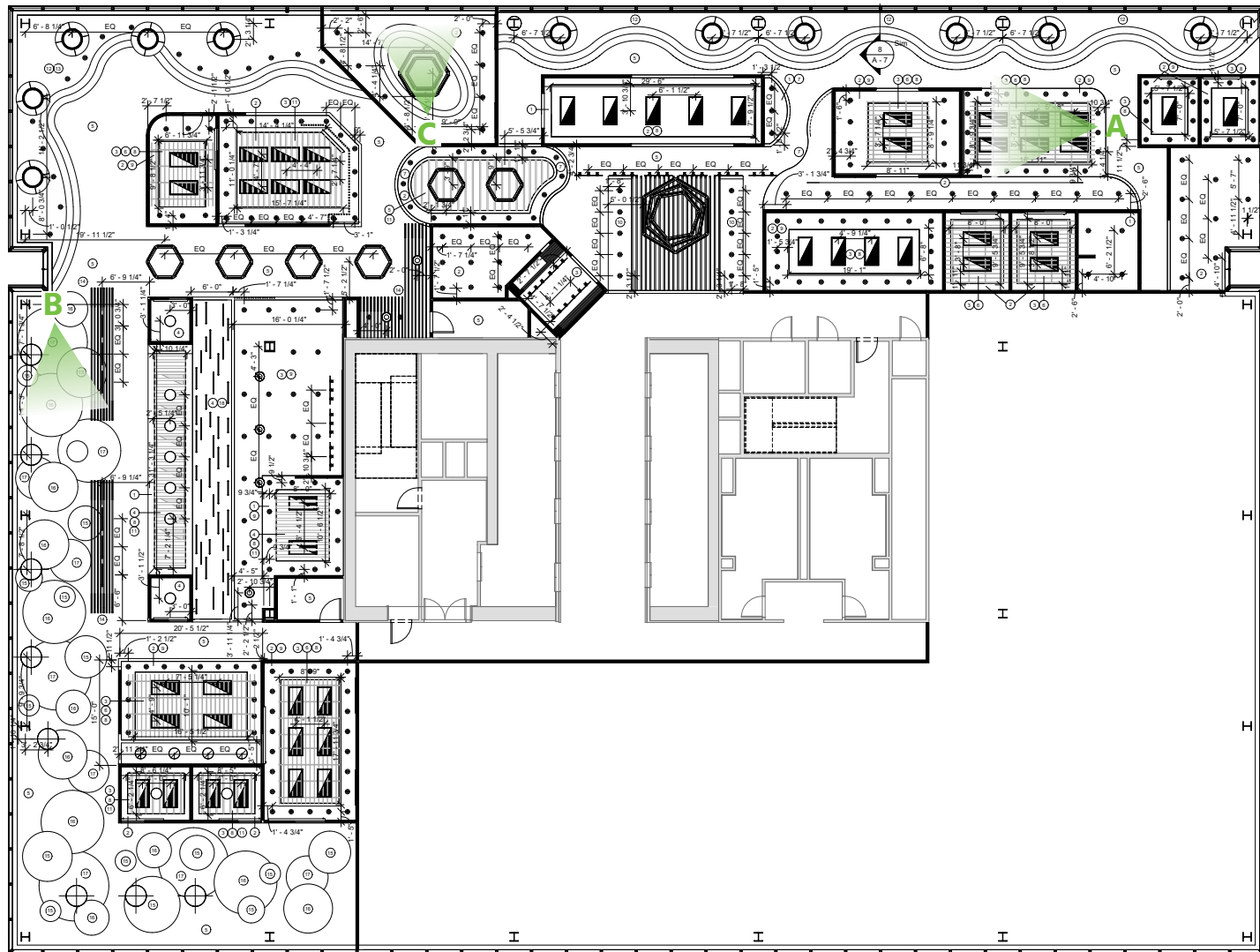

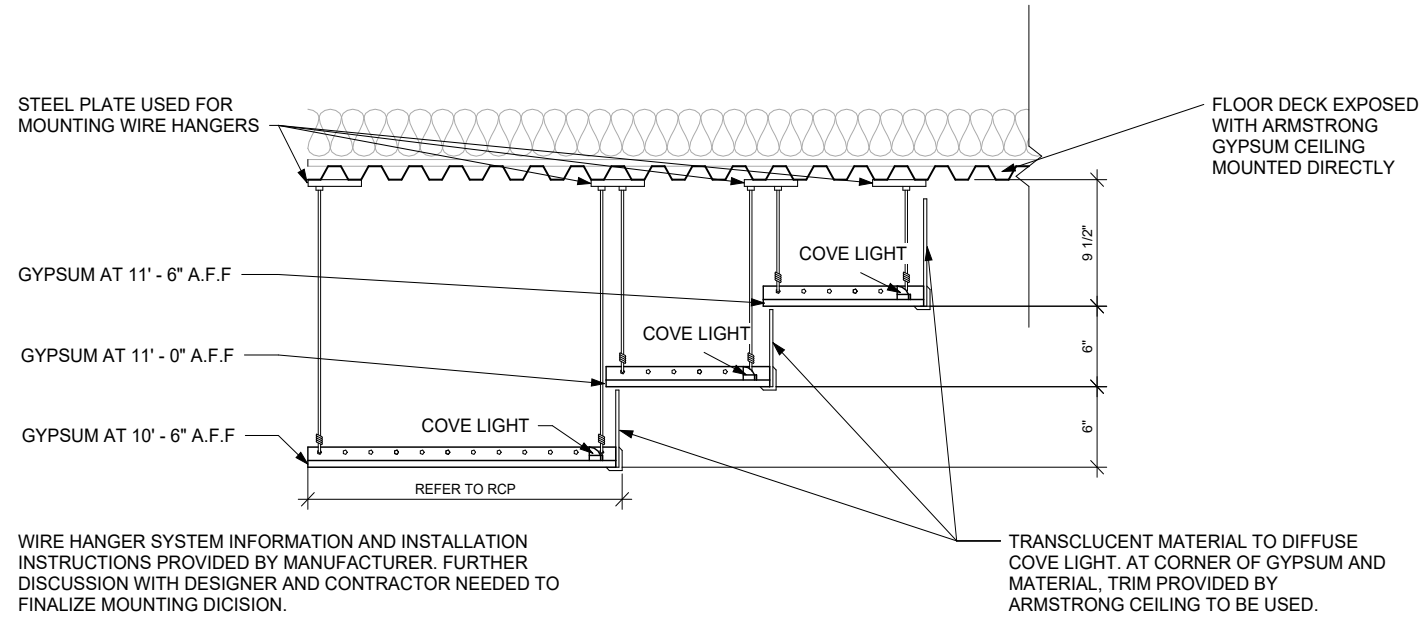
RENDERED FLOOR PLAN THROUGH REVIT

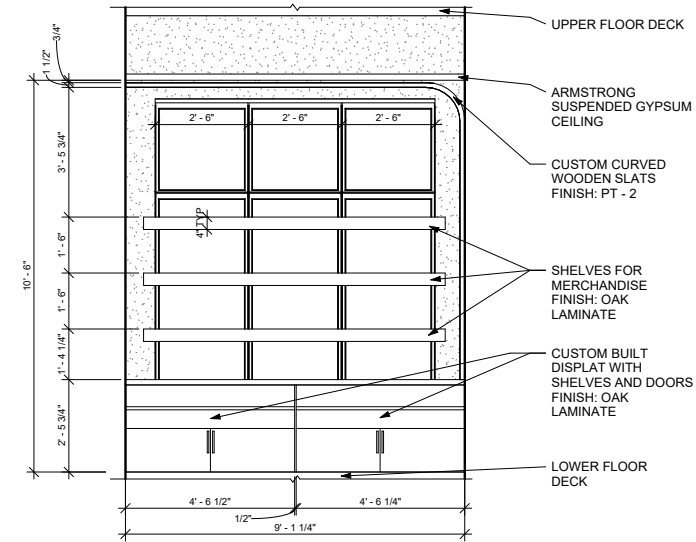

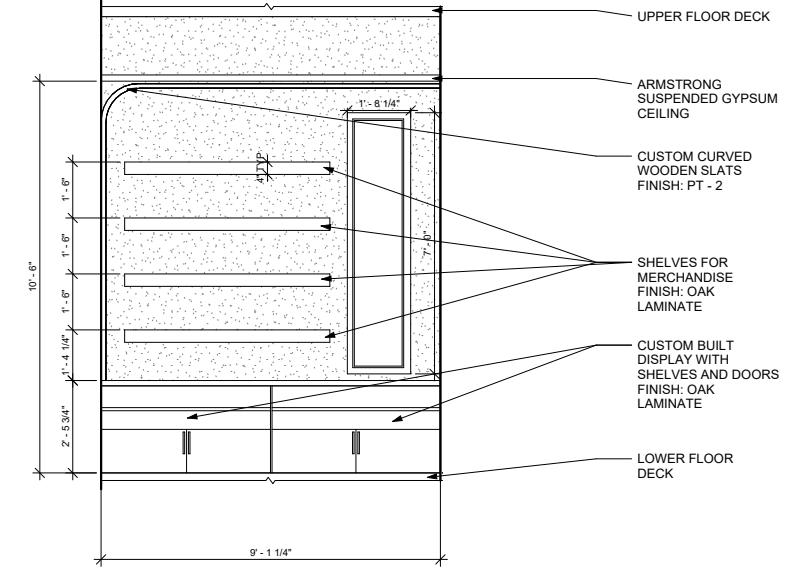

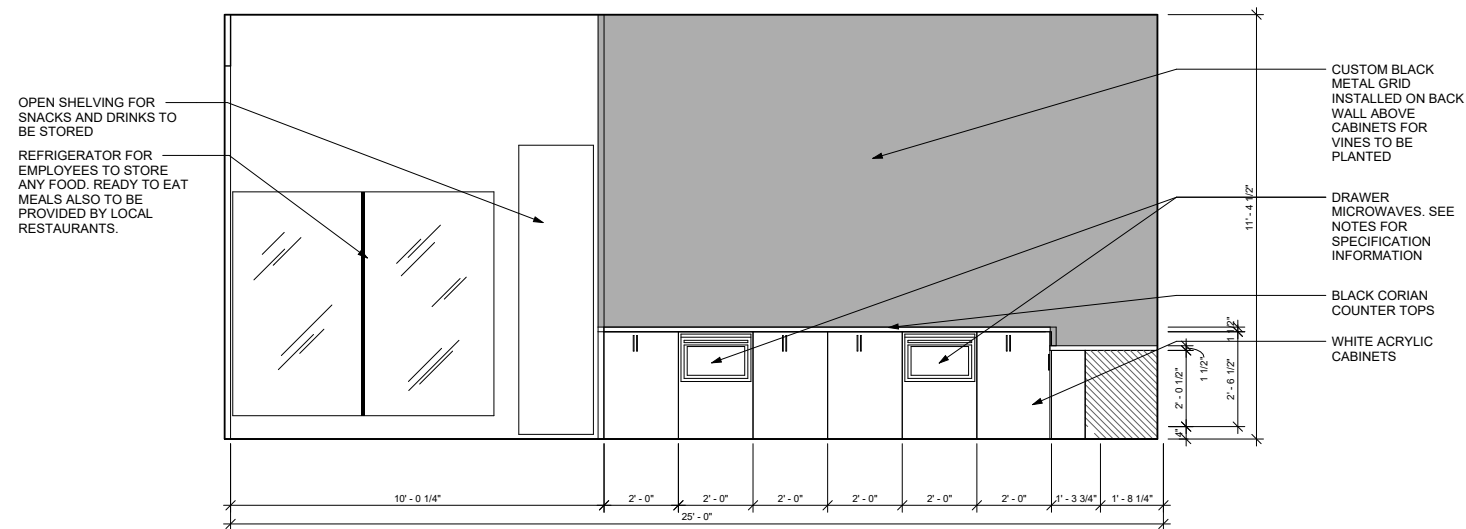

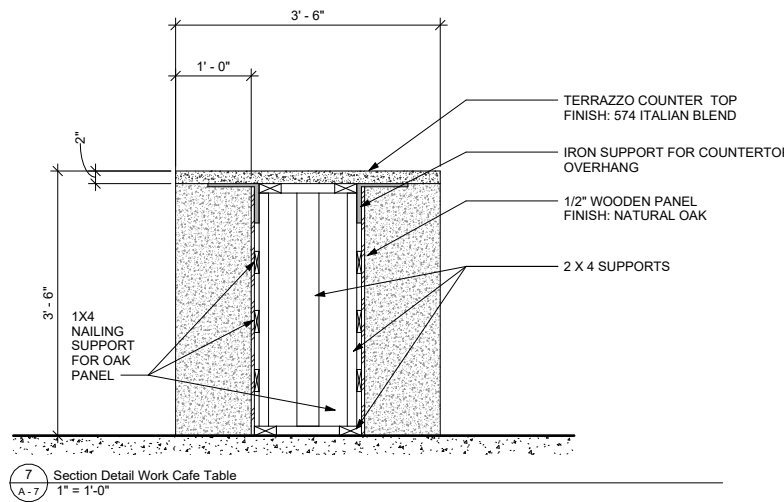

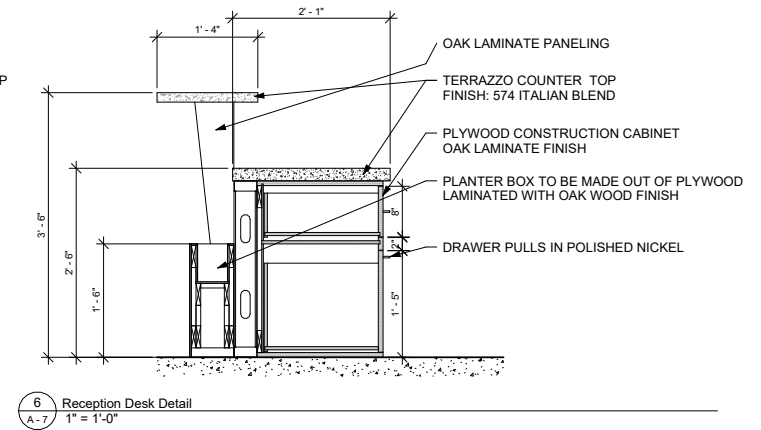

The Radius is a sleek modern club and venue that focuses on stimulating the body's senses in response to designing for the hearing impaired. - Sight is incorporated by the use of LED screens throughout the space.
- Touch is incorporated with sensory backpacks that vibrate with the music that is played.

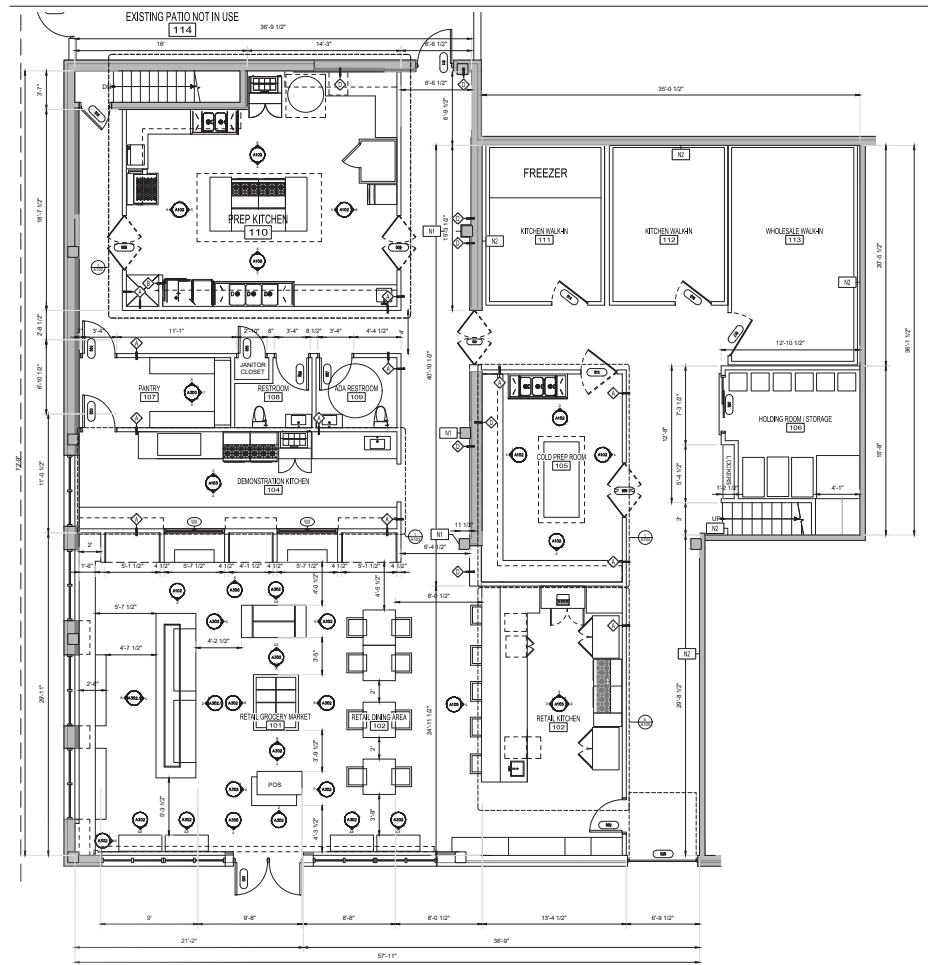
