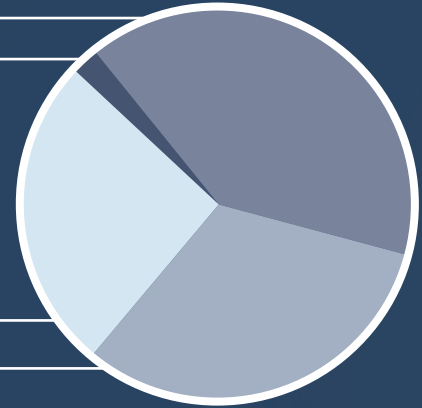

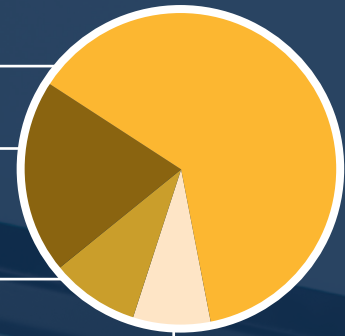
Top priorities for faculty and staff
