

Position: Graduate Assistant for Residence Life Conduct and Case Management

Position Description

- Create and maintain the audit for Housing and Residence Life related conduct reports, tracking compliance of local, state, and federal regulations pertaining to the conduct process.
- Utilize the campus conduct software, Maxient.
- Perform conduct hearings for minor violations and adjudicate sanctions.
- Execute the process for information reports involving minor housing policy violations (i.e., candles and/or accidental fire alarms).
- Assist Assistant Directors and Resident Directors with the scanning and uploading of hearing officer forms along with any additional case documentation as needed.
- Assist with follow-up for students of concern experiencing personal, academic, and social challenges provided to the department from campus partners
- Assist with the coordination of resources and referrals.
- Maintain accurate and confidential case notes and documentation.
- Assist in assessing and improving case management processes and services.
- Serve on various committees, as assigned.
- Plan and create documents to report appropriate data to various stakeholders.
- Other duties as assigned, based on the needs of the department.

Position Requirements

- 20 hours per week
- Applicant must be admitted to a graduate degree program at UT Chattanooga and enrolled in classes for the concurrent academic year.
- Housing and Residence Life experience preferred
- Strong time management, organization, critical thinking, collaborative spirit and enthusiasm preferred
- Self-starter with ability to think outside of the box preferred
