III. Updates on Other Academic Initiatives

- **AMFY (A Moc's First Year—10 Year Success Initiative)**
 - Paired Courses with Cohort Registration to Enhance Social and Academic Connections
 - Phased in with a goal of reaching all first-time full-time students by year 10
 - Fall 2024 Goal was 30 Communities—Achieved 51 paired sections serving 976 students
 - Fall 2025 Goal is 60 paired Sections—71 are confirmed + 8 are proposed and pending approval
- **University High & Dual Enrollment**
 - Fall 2024 Enrollment 106 Dual Enrollment including University High Junior and Seniors, and Dual Enrollment students attending other high schools
 - By contrast, there were 65 dual enrollment students in Fall 2023
 - All U High Seniors have applied to UTC—81% accepted so far
 - More than half encouraged to apply for UTC Honors program
 - 36% eligible for Provost Scholarship (3.4 and 25 ACT)
 - 4% eligible for Chancellor's Scholarship (3.5 and 29 ACT)
