

## Master of Business Administration (MBA) vs. MS Management (MSM)

MBA	MSM
Two modalities: 100% Online Asynchronous <b>OR</b> Flexible  Online: Courses delivered entirely online through Canvas Flexible: Courses delivered in both face-to-face and online formats at different times	One modality: 100% Online Asynchronous  Courses delivered entirely online through Canvas, UTC's learning management system

Five concentrations available including Accounting, Business Analytics, Finance, General and Healthcare Administration	This specialized Master of Science in Management degree does not offer concentrations or electives

### Common to Both MBA & MSM Programs

Access to an academic advisor to aid in course selection
Four start dates available: Fall, Spring, Summer 1, and Summer 2
Admission criteria and application process are identical between the two programs
Financial aid available for students who take 6 credit hours or more per semester
Graduate Assistantship positions are available to students who apply, qualify, and are selected. All GA's must be able to travel to campus as requested by supervisor
Access to career coaches and job search resources tailored to graduate-level students
