

# A Step-By-Step Guide to Choosing Your Mentor

## 1. FIND YOUR GO-TO

- **THAT TEACHER YOU REALLY CONNECT WITH**
- **A STAFF MEMBER WHO ALWAYS HELPS YOU OUT, LIKE YOUR ADVISOR OR YOUR DEPARTMENT ADMIN.**
- **YOUR RA WHO HELPED YOU FIGURE OUT YOUR FIRST PARKING TICKET**

You are required to meet with a mentor at least one time each semester.

Picking someone you already connect with gives you a better chance at forming a more meaningful mentor-mentee relationship

## 3. LOG YOUR FIRST MEETING

### SUBMIT YOUR MENTOR MEETING



To remain eligible for your scholarship, you'll need to submit this form to report your mentor meeting.

## 2. ASK THEM TO BE YOUR MENTOR

**SEND THEM AN EMAIL OR CATCH THEM AFTER CLASS, BE SURE YOU RECEIVE AN AFFIRMATIVE REPLY**
