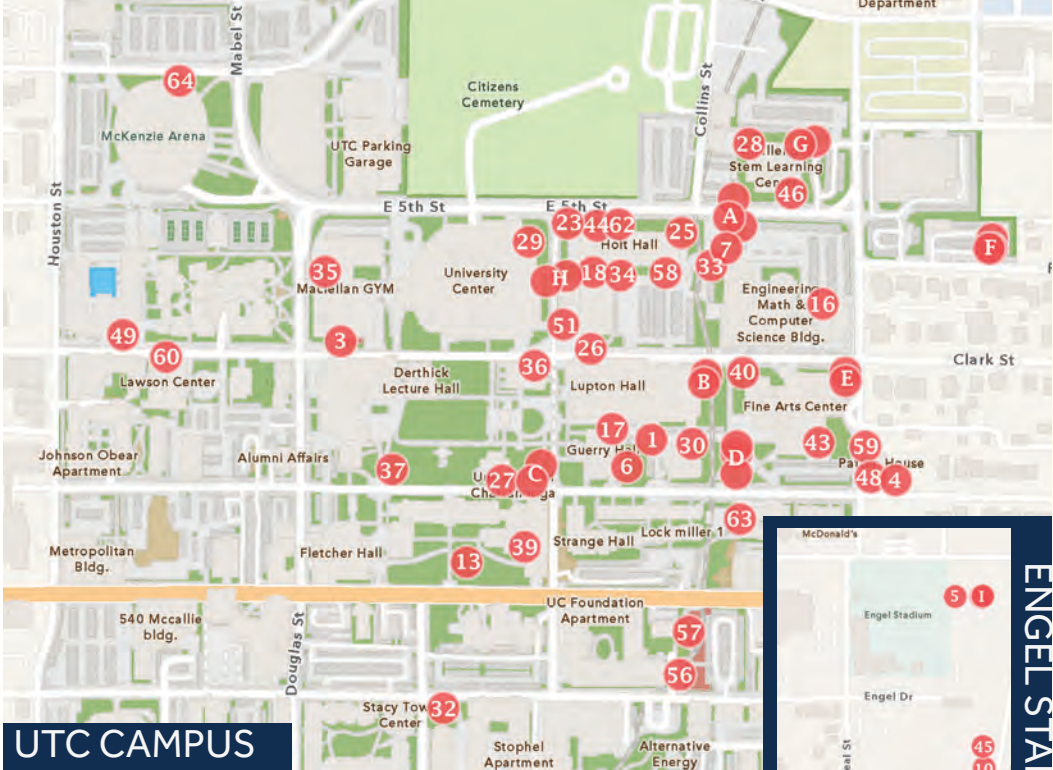

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UTC is considered a Level II Arboretum, certified by the Tennessee Urban Forestry Council.
