We provide **academic advisement, mentoring and career counseling** for **freshman, sophomore, junior, and senior students** who are majoring in Chemistry.

Academic Advisement:

Prior to signing up for the next semester of classes, each student should schedule an advisement session where the advisor will discuss the student's course of study. The Departmental Professional Advisor will schedule appointments online through *Navigate*. Be on time for your appointment and bring a list of classes completed (such as MyMocs Degree list) and a list of what you expect to take in the next semester. To progress in your course work, you must look at the online catalog course descriptions so you can plan for the pre- and co-requisites requirements for your courses.
